

City Departments that provide programs and services for people with disabilities:

**City Clerk - 866-2925**

Temporary parking placard available. Doctors' certification on application required. Paratransit (PACE) information for accessible travel route.

**City of Evanston Job Hotline - 448-8110**

Equal opportunity employment.

**Commission on Aging - 866-2919**

Resources on long term care facilities, resolves resident's complaints, and advocates for resident's legal rights.

**Community Development / Property Standards - 866-2927**

Inspects for property maintenance violations.

**Evanston Public Library - 866-0305**

Accessible computer workstation is available for visually impaired/blind and mobility impaired persons.

**Health Department - 866-2948**

Clinics for immunizations, well child, family planning, dental, and testing for sexually transmitted diseases.

**Housing Rehabilitation - 866-2929**

Assistance with housing rehabilitation, tree removal, garage demolition, and self-help paint program.

**Human Relations - 866-2920 TTY: 328-4080**

Enforcement of municipal housing, employment, accessibility laws and ordinances.

**Parking - 866-2206**

Reserved handicapped parking space in front of home or apartment. Doctor's note documenting nature of disability required for this program.

**Recreation - 866-2910 TTY: 448-8064**

Programs/services for children and adults with special needs. Summer day camps in coop with District 65.

**Subsidized Taxicab Program**

Low-cost transportation is available to mobility-impaired residents and qualifying seniors. Coupons cost \$2 per trip and can be purchased through the City Collector's Office, the Levy Center and the Evanston United Way.

Complaints about curb cuts, handicap parking signs, and/or obstruction of path on existing sidewalk(s).
