City of Evanston Ridge Avenue Improvement Project



Project Description

This notice is to inform the residents, businesses and property owners on or near the Ridge Avenue/Mulford Street intersection that a temporary detour (**See back of page**) will be in effect from 9:00AM to 8:00PM on Monday and Tuesday, July 7 & 8 for North bound Ridge Avenue traffic. During this stage of the Ridge Avenue roadway construction work, it was determined that two older brick sanitary manholes near the Mulford intersection needed to be replaced. The depths of the manholes are over 15 feet and they cannot be replaced in a safe manner with moving traffic next to the excavation. Therefore, the existing single lane northbound Ridge Avenue traffic will be detoured. There shall be flaggers at every cross street to direct local traffic. The construction sequence includes excavation and removal of old manholes, installation of the new concrete manholes, backfilling the excavation and pouring the concrete base before opening the single north bound traffic on Ridge Avenue.
