## PUBLIC SKATE RULES

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all guests, the following rules are strictly enforced:

1. Reckless or negligent skating, including roughness, excessive speed, or weaving through other skaters, is strictly prohibited.
2. Horseplay or unsafe games on the ice, including but not limited to tag or racing, are not permitted.
3. No more than two (2) skaters may hold hands at any time.
4. All skaters must move in the designated direction of traffic and remain in motion.
5. Skate helpers (walkers) are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
6. Skates are permitted only on the ice surface and protective matting. Skates are not allowed in the bleacher areas.
7. Throwing snowballs or any other objects is strictly prohibited.
8. Ball or puck play of any kind, including hockey or catch, is not permitted during public skate sessions.
9. Jumps, spins, and advanced figure skating maneuvers are prohibited.
10. Food, beverages, and gum are not permitted on the ice.
11. Shoes are not allowed on the ice. Skaters must wear appropriate ice skates during all skating sessions.
12. For safety reasons, the use of headphones, cellular phones, or other electronic devices while skating is prohibited.
13. Skating while carrying a child or any other individual is not permitted.
14. Profanity, abusive or obscene language, disruptive behavior, and fighting will not be tolerated.
15. Loitering on the ice or in hockey boxes is prohibited. Guests may not sit on or lean over the boards.

16. All patrons must treat others with respect and courtesy, regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability.
17. Guests are expected to respect the facility and promptly report any damage or misconduct to management.
18. All instructions from rink guards and staff must be followed at all times.
19. After a fall, skaters should make every effort to stand promptly to maintain a safe skating environment.
20. In the event of an injury, notify a rink guard or staff member immediately.
21. Robert Crown Community Center is not responsible for unattended, lost, or stolen items.
22. Skating is undertaken at the participant's own risk.
23. Rental skates must be returned immediately at the conclusion of each session.
24. Skaters must exit the ice promptly when directed. Skating is strictly prohibited while the Zamboni is on the ice or when Zamboni doors are open.
25. Guests are asked to assist in maintaining the cleanliness of the facility by disposing of all trash in designated receptacles.
26. All children must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian when not actively participating in skating.
27. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the immediate termination of skating privileges without refund.
