


# NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING #4

The fourth and final neighborhood meeting was held at the ETHS Transition House at 1742 Lemar Avenue on Tuesday, October 3rd from 6 to 8 p.m. The meeting format/agenda included:

**“Consider wildlife mitigation”**

**“For Emerson trail underpass, be thoughtful of boat traffic that moves under Emerson - they need two lanes to safely pass in both directions”**

**“More lights” (near the parking lot)**

**“More trees”**

**“Provide fence by the channel for safety”**

**“Rodent control during construction process”**

**“Look into dog waste stations”**

**“Provide safe crosswalk with signage and blinking lights” (at Main Street)**
