Project: Twiggs Park Playground Renovations

Meeting Date: January 21, 2025, 6 pm

Unfortunately, due to inclement weather, the meeting was very minimally attended and resulted in a quick presentation by Stefanie with the intent that an additional public meeting would be necessary.

Stefanie went through the planned presentation, first showing existing conditions, followed by the data analysis performed on the three public inquiries to date (public meeting #1, Councilmember Burns questionnaire with the Joanna Avery's Summer Camp, and the online public inquiry). It was then explained how the analyzed data was incorporated into the new concepts.

The 2-5 playground then had two concepts explained showing varied types of play, a main slide structure, musical elements, sensory elements, and swings. These concepts varied in overall look and color but have the same overall design program.

The 5-12 playground had three concepts presented that focused on separation/circuitous elements as needed for funding purposes. These concepts included main structures, climbing walls, ziplines, swings, and ninja courses.





