





Transportation Committee Approves NWMC Bike Plan RFQ

On Thursday, the NWMC Transportation Committee approved the draft request for qualifications (RFQ) for updates to the 2010 NWMC Bicycle Plan. In addition to the plan update, the RFQ seeks to expand the plan's scope to include a review of transit access in the region. Staff will seek funding for the plan update through CMAP's Local Technical Assistance (LTA) program and, pending NWMC Executive Board and funding approval, anticipates releasing the RFQ in late summer or early fall.

Representatives from the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) held an interactive discussion of Alternative Futures. Used in developing the ON TO 2050 regional comprehensive plan, Alternative Futures envisions scenarios based on emerging trends and their potential impact on the region. The committee discussed the five scenarios, including: a changed climate; walkable communities; innovative transportation; a transformed economy; and, constrained resources. Finally, the Committee heard a presentation on the ongoing O'Hare Sub Region Truck Routing and Infrastructure Plan. This plan involves fifteen municipalities surrounding O'Hare airport and aims to help municipalities deal with the increased freight traffic the airport and surrounding developments will produce. The project team analyzed freight traffic in the study area and has proposed a truck routing network as well as policy recommendations. SPC Renews Fuel Contract

The Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) Governing Board has awarded the first of three (3) possible, one-year contract extensions on Gasoline, Diesel Fuel, Ethanol and Bio Diesel Fuel (Contract #159) to MBE vendor Gas Depot Company of *Morton Grove*. The contract extension is effective July 6, 2017 through July 5, 2018. Pricing will remain the same, with the exception of a \$.06/gallon price increase for fuel deliveries of less than 2,500 gallons. The contract extension also contains the following changes to the product offerings:

- Suppliers no longer offer 92 octanes, so 93 octanes are the only Premium No-Lead option.

- The 70/30 blend is a combination of #2 grade diesel and #1 grade diesel. Since OPIS has a separate accounting of each product and since the SPC requires mark-up on each product, the 70/30 blend is obsolete.
- Separate line items for E75 and E85 have been combined as the suppliers/terminals need to adjust the amount of ethanol throughout the year by mandate of the EPA. Depending on the time of year the product name changes. For example, January thru March it may be E75 and April through August, E85.
- Due to demand for bio-blends, B2, B5, B11 and B20 fuels have been added as line items.
