Governor Calls Special Session to Consider New Budget Proposal; Local Revenues Slashed With two weeks to go until the state enters a third straight fiscal year without a budget, Governor Rauner on Thursday called a ten-day special session of the General Assembly to consider a new budget proposal. Legislators will return to the capitol on Wednesday, June 21 and are expected be in session every day until the end of the month or passage of a budget (whichever comes first). Initial focus is expected to center on the budget introduced by the House and Senate Republicans on Thursday. Although staff is still in the process of analyzing the proposal, we can report it includes: a permanent 10% reduction in the Local Government Distributive Fund (approximately \$13.5 million from NWMC members); diversion of local home rule and nonhome rule sales tax revenues; continued diversions from the Personal Property Replacement Tax; and, a voter initiated process for consolidating units of local government. The proposal also calls for a four-year property tax freeze that permits exemptions for existing debt service payments and allows a mechanism for voters to lower their property tax levies via referendum.

Although the budget is the only item that may be considered during the official special session, there is nothing to prevent legislative leadership from calling a regular session following the special session. This would allow legislators to take up a number of pending bills, including the Small Wireless Facilities Deployment Act (Senate Bill 1451). We expect to have more information soon (including potential Action Alerts) and expect to publish a Legislative Update next Friday. *Staff contacts: Mark Fowler, Larry Bury, Chris Staron*

On Wednesday, the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) sent notification to contractors on state and federally funded construction projects to prepare for a work shutdown due to the state's continuing budget impasse. Without a state budget or legislation providing obligation authority, IDOT will be unable to pay contractors after June 30. All construction work must stop by that date and contractors have been given this advanced notice in order to secure construction sites.
