The Mayor's Summer Youth Employment Program annual job fair will be held on Saturday, March 12, 2016, at Evanston Township High School. Doors will open at 8:00am and close at 1:30pm. Young adults between the ages of 14 through 18 that live in zip code areas 60201 and 60202 are eligible to participate in the job fair. Last year, nearly 600 young adults obtained employment through the City and other local businesses in the community.
