### MWRD Proposes Changes to Watershed Management Ordinance

### Time to Adopt the GRC2

Earlier this year, the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus released the Greenest Region Compact 2 (GRC2), which consists of a pledge and supporting resources that "will unify municipal action towards consensus sustainability goals and will support mayors in their role as environmental leaders." GRC2 builds upon the

original Greenest Region Compact, which was adopted by nearly one hundred municipalities (including 22 NWMC members) in 2007. The Caucus again asks that municipalities adopt GRC2, which will build the necessary support to obtain the technical and financial assistance to implement the program's strategies and projects. There is no requirement to take specific action at this point, though a future supportive program to assist and track progress, called the Sustainability Network, is planned. That said, board endorsement of the GRC2 shows unified support for sustainability in the region and will help leverage resources for implementation.

To date, the following NWMC members have reported adoption of the GRC2: *Barrington; Cary; Fox Lake; Highland Park; Hoffman Estates; Lake Bluff; Lincolnwood; Mount Prospect; Niles; Northfield; Schaumburg; Streamwood;* and, *Wheeling*.
