Subject: Safe Routes to School Project Update

On August 15, 2016, City Council approved Resolution 55-R-16 authorizing the City Manager to sign the Local Public Agency Agreement for Federal Participation with the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") in participation of the Safe Routes to School Project. Last week, IDOT opened the bids for the installation of 20 radar speed feedback solar signs at various school crosssing locations on major streets in the City. The low bid was submitted by Utility Dynamics Corporation (23 Commerce Drive, Oswego IL 60543) in the amount of \$115,800.00. IDOT is seeking the City's concurrence to award the project to the low bidder and staff recommends approving the award. This exceeds the originally authorized amount of \$110,000 by \$5,800.

Funding for this work will be from the CIP Fund, which has \$40,000 budgeted in 2017. The initial project cost was estimated at \$110,000. This included \$88,000 to be paid for by the federal grant, and the remaining \$22,000 to be paid for by the City's local share. The additional \$5,800 would be paid entirely by the City.

The radar speed feedback signs are effective tools for showing the automobile drivers the speeds that they are driving at any given time, and assist them to better comply with the posted speed limits. The proposed locations are recommended based on designated school crossing locations on major streets and traffic concerns or citations. Staff has installed similar radar signs at various locations in the City on temporary basis with success. These signs will calm the traffic near the locations where the school children walk. The SRTS Program is federally funded and administered by IDOT.
