Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee Tour Skokie Valley Trail

On Tuesday, the NWMC Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee met at the Emily Oaks Nature Center in *Skokie*. Staff from the *Village of Lincolnwood* discussed two recently completed multi-use paths, the Valley Line Trail and the UP Recreation Path. The Valley Line Trail features a soon-to-be completed overpass that will allow users to safely cross Touhy Avenue. Skokie staff discussed their recently completed Skokie Valley Trail path as well as bike lanes on Main Street and a one-day, pop-up bike lane event held in conjunction with the Active Transportation Alliance.

NWMC staff briefed the committee on the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning's (CMAP) draft programs for the federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) and Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP). The draft CMAQ program, <u>http://www.cmap.illinois.gov/mobility/strategic-investment/cmaq/program-development</u>, is currently open for public comment and will be voted on by the CMAP board in October. Staff also updated the committee on the recently announced Invest in Cook grant awards. This program, in its inaugural year, aims to further the goals identified in Connecting Cook County, the county's long-range transportation plan. Ideas Flow at "Doing More with Less in 2050" Forum

On Tuesday, the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) co-hosted a forum at the *Libertyville Civic Center* with the Northwest Municipal Conference, Lake County Municipal League and McHenry County Council of Governments to explore how communities and the region will adapt in an era of constrained state and federal resources. Entitled "Doing More with Less in 2050", the event included a panel discussion moderated by Daily Herald Columnist and Senior Writer Kerry Lester and with the following panelists: John S. Gates Jr., Chairman and CEO, PortaeCo, LLC; the Honorable Leon Rockingham, Mayor, North Chicago; Megan McKenna, Executive Director, Mano a Mano Resource Center; and, Paula Wolff, Director, Illinois Justice Project.

The panelists gave their perspectives on the opportunities and pitfalls that local governments will face in the future, including the impact of constrained resources on local government budgets and service delivery. They cited examples from their local government experiences and highlighted existing shared services and joint purchasing initiatives throughout the region. Attendees offered numerous ideas, ranging from improved pedestrian facilities for senior citizens to consolidation of municipal facilities (i.e. shared village halls ?!?).

This forum was the last in a series held by CMAP to explore alternative future scenarios as the agency develops the "ON TO 2005" regional comprehensive plan, which is expected to be approved in October.
