### Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee Discusses Upcoming Year

On Tuesday, the NWMC Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee met to discuss the committee's goals and meeting topics for the year. Committee members who were not able to attend are encouraged to submit their ideas for meeting topics to staff. Staff also discussed the potential municipal impacts of two newly enacted Illinois laws concerning electric or "e-bikes" and vehicle passing distances.

Finally, the committee reviewed and discussed a recently published toolkit for municipalities created by the Active Transportation Alliance. "Working Collaboratively with IDOT" provides guidance for municipalities on how to incorporate bicycle, pedestrian and complete streets accommodations into existing IDOT projects. ### **IDOT** Announces Transportation Enhancement Project Call for Projects

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) has announced that Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) applications will be accepted beginning October 2. Applications are due by December 1 and the proposed program will be announced in Spring 2018. Applicants may apply for up to \$2,000,000 maximum per project, with approximately \$40,000,000 total available statewide. Under the program, preliminary engineering, utility relocations, construction engineering, and construction costs require an 80% federal match, while right-of-way acquisition requires a 50% match. Street lighting can qualify for either a 50% or 80% match, depending on whether the location is within a designated historic district.

Eligible projects include: pedestrian/bicycle facilities; streetscapes; conversion of abandoned railroad corridors to trails; historic preservation and rehabilitation of historic transportation facilities; vegetation management in transportation rights-of-way; and, storm water management, control and water pollution prevention or abatement related to highway construction or due to highway runoff. Ineligible project types include: general

road work (i.e. resurfacing); recreational trails and stand-alone landscape; bicycle lockers/racks; pedestrian crossings; and, street/pedestrian lighting projects.
