Road Closure and Detour

Northbound Asbury Avenue from Church Street to Emerson Street

April 14, 2016

Project Description

The City of Evanston is completing a project involving the rehabilitation of the City's public combined sewer lines using the Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) process. During this process, a liner is inserted into the public sewer by equipment staged at ground level. The entire process takes about 10 hours, during which time construction equipment will be staged in the street and traffic patterns will be modified, including a road closure and detour. The contractor performing the work is Insituform Technologies.

Detour Schedule

This work will take place in the intersection of Emerson Street and Asbury Avenue, partially blocking the intersection. To create a safe work zone, the contractor will close northbound Asbury to all but local traffic between Church Street and Emerson Street. A detour will be in place to guide non-local northbound traffic around the work zone via Ridge Avenue. There will be signage in the area to assist vehicles and pedestrians during working hours. Southbound Asbury Avenue will remain open the entire time.

The contractor will perform the sewer lining work at night to minimize disruptions from the detour. The road closure and detour will begin at 8:00 pm on Tuesday, April 26, and end at 7:00 am on April 27, *weather permitting*.

Please stay alert and thank you for your patience as the City completes this important infrastructure renewal project.
