



City of Evanston 2016 Parking Lot Improvement Project

September 22, 2016

Project Description

The City will be contracting parking lot improvements at the following three locations over the next six weeks. Work will include improvements as summarized below.

James Park West Parking Lot

Improvements include asphalt resurfacing of the existing pavement, reconstruction of the lot entrances to improve circulation, landscaping and the addition of LED parking lot lighting.

Work is scheduled to begin **the week of October 3 and be completed by October 21**. The lot will be completely closed to the public from October 4 to October 14 and closed during daytime work hours from October 17 to October 21.

Parking Lot #32 (800 Block of Hinman Avenue)

Improvements include reconstruction of the existing pavement with both conventional asphalt and porous concrete paver blocks, replacement of the existing lot lighting with new foundations, poles and LED lighting, landscaping and the addition of a rain garden to take advantage of the sandy soils in this area.

Work is scheduled to begin **the week of October 10 and be completed by November 4**. Due to the scope of work at this location the lot is expected to be completely closed for the entire four week period.

Police Headquarters Parking Lot (1454 Elmwood Avenue)

Improvements include asphalt resurfacing of the existing asphalt pavement, repair of the existing retaining walls leading to the underground parking area, concrete sidewalk and curb repairs as needed and remarking of the entire lot.

Work is scheduled to begin **the week of October 10 and be completed by October 21**. The lot is expected to be completely closed to traffic for five days during this two week period.

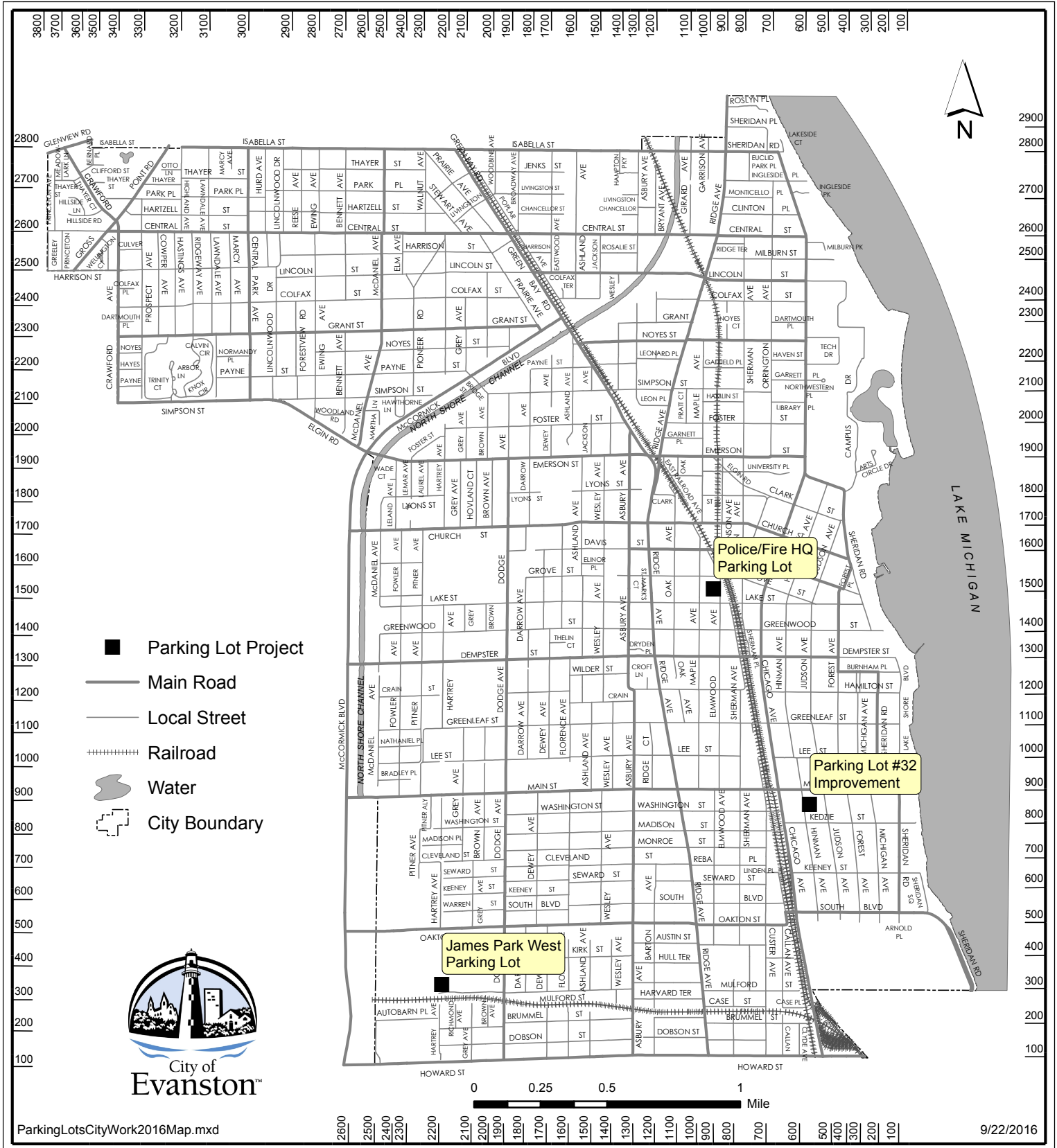
