First Time Home Buyer Education!



HODC's First Time Home Buyer Education program is offered as a series of three workshops: **Pre-Purchase, Credit and Budgeting, and Contract to Close**, and is designed to empower future homeowners in the homebuying process. The sessions cover readiness to purchase a home, how to manage credit and create a budget, and what to expect during the closing process. Participants also will be provided information about fair housing.

Upon completion of the course, participants will receive a certificate of completion valid for one year - which is required for most down payment assistance programs.

Individualized counseling sessions are also available by appointment.
