



Protect My Town

As we reported last week, the NWMC has joined fellow councils of governments and municipalities in the "Protect My Town" coalition, which is a statewide initiative aimed at activating Illinois residents to voice their opposition to proposed cuts in local revenue. Reminder: RTA Seeking Access to Transit Projects

The Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) is holding a call for projects for its Access to Transit program. The program helps municipalities receive capital funding for small-scale projects to improve transit access. To qualify, projects must be directly related to improving access to existing transit services and may include improvements such as: sidewalks; crosswalks; bus and rail shelters; ADA accessibility improvements; covered bicycle parking; and, wayfinding signage. The RTA bundles the selected Access to Transit projects for submittal to the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) for funding under the federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program. Submittal by the RTA of approved projects will occur in the fall of 2019.

Eligible applicants must have completed, or be in the process of completing, a planning or implementation project through the RTA's Community Planning or Interagency Signage programs or CMAP's Local Technical Assistance (LTA) Program. Communities with projects selected by the RTA must pay for and have completed Phase I engineering (if needed) prior to the project being submitted for CMAQ funding. The maximum project budget has

been increased from \$500,000 to \$1 million, with a minimum budget of \$150,000 now required. Most projects require a 20% local match, which will be equally shared between the RTA and the applicant, with each contributing 10% of the total project budget. The RTA may provide the full 20% match rate for smaller communities and those with lower tax bases or median incomes based on the economic and demographic characteristics of the area served. Eligible applicants may contact the RTA to determine if they qualify for this exemption. Applications are due via e-mail by the close of business on August 31.
