



Subject: City of Evanston Amazon.com Spending Guidelines

Date: August 17, 2018

In an effort to move Amazon.com spend to local businesses, City Manager Bobkiewicz proposed the following policy to the MWEBE Committee for their consideration. The Amazon spending guidelines will be rolled out to Directors and Staff August 20, 2018 with an effective date of September 1, 2018.

- 1. City staff will be allowed to use Amazon.com for purchases of only approved commodities.
- 2. All City purchases through Amazon.com must be made through the City Amazon Business account, administered through the Purchasing Division. Individual Department accounts will not be allowed.
- 3. All purchases will be reported to the City Council through the Bills List, plus a separate quarterly report aggregating all purchases.
- 4. Department Directors may request that the City Manager add commodities to the approved list. Changes to the list of approved commodities will be shared with the City Council quarterly. These requests must detail that the commodity is not available for purchase in Evanston or through an existing local vendor agreement. In addition, the City may add a commodity if the department can justify operational cost savings using Amazon.
- 5. When procuring goods and services, staff should shop Evanston merchants first.

Northwest Municipal Conference Accomplishments Profiled in 2017-2018 Annual Report

The 2017-2018 fiscal year was a busy one for the Northwest Municipal Conference. The recently published NWMC FY 2017-2018 Annual Report compiles a comprehensive list of accomplishments that may have been overlooked during the year. For example, the NWMC oversaw gross sales of approximately \$55 million to over 400 unique entities through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative. The NWMC hosted legislative negotiations on the Small Wireless Facilities Deployment Act while tracking over 350 bills. The NWMC programmed \$15 million in federally funded Surface Transportation Program projects. The NWMC completed 150 surveys, providing timely information to Conference decision makers. Northwest Council of Mayors Talks Changes to the Surface Transportation Program

The Northwest Council of Mayors Technical Committee met Thursday at the *Barrington Village Hall*. Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) Senior Program Analyst Kama Dobbs presented the proposed scoring system and project selection criteria for the new Surface Transportation Program (STP) regional Shared Fund. The Technical Committee raised a number of specific concerns about the scoring system and selection criteria, which are being compiled and will be transmitted to CMAP. In addition, Ms. Dobbs fielded questions on the proposed Active Program Management rules for all STP projects in the region.

The Technical Committee approved a revised list of STP projects based on expected letting or obligation dates of upcoming projects.
