#### I. Call to Order / Declaration of Quorum

D. Stoneback called the meeting to order.

#### II. Approval of Meeting Minutes:

#### a. Regular Meeting - March 13, 2018

- L. Biggs made a motion to approve minutes from March 13, 2018.
- A. King seconded the motion. All in favor.

#### III. Land Vacation at 1633 Florence

- D. Stoneback changed order of meeting to address land vacation at 1633 Florence before other items.
- S. Nagar gave overview of land vacation request at 1633 Florence. Process started in 2016 with coordination between City staff, ATT, and resident. An alley and triangular parcel in the right of way of Church St. are recommended to be vacated to Peter Isaac for \$16,000, based on the appraisal value.
- D. Stoneback further discussed the plan and recommended that the Board motion to send the vacation to City Council.
- L. Biggs made a motion to create an ordinance for City Council regarding the land vacation at 1633 Florence.
- A. King seconded the motion. All in favor.

#### V. Alley Projects Update

C. Venatta provided the board with current status of the 2017 alleys in which all of the five alleys have been completed and final payments have been issued. Final Rolls for the special assessment alleys are on the agenda to be approved later in the meeting.

- C. Venatta updated the board on the status of the 2018 alleys. The 2018 special assessment alley and CDBG alley are out to bid with an expected award at the August 13<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting. The special assessment alley is pending a court hearing in Cook County court. The other three 2018 alleys are on-hold.
- D. Stoneback requested legal send land acquisition letters for the 2019 alley with a response date by August 31<sup>st</sup>. M. Treto said the letters would be sent in the coming weeks.

- C. Venatta gave an overview of the final 2017 budget numbers.
- L. Biggs suggested taking excess special assessment funds and using them to fund additional alleys in 2019. A. King said the finance department would put a memo together on this topic for the next meeting.

  - E. Cano seconded the motion. All in favor.

#### ii. Special Assessment 1522 – North of Simpson St. East of Railroad ROW

- C. Venatta gave overview of final rolls. Assessed cost to residents will be less than anticipated. The City took on a larger portion of the expenses due to the Railroad ROW.
- L. Biggs made a motion to approve the final roll for Special Assessment 1522.
- E. Cano seconded the motion. All in favor.

- D. Stoneback noted that this topic was discussed during the Alley Projects Update.
