



Bike-Ped Committee Talks NWMC Multi-Modal Plan, New STP Programs, Procedures

The NWMC Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee met Tuesday to discuss the status of the NWMC Multimodal Plan, changes to the region's Surface Transportation Program (STP) and grant opportunities available through the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) and the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT).

NWMC staff updated the committee on the NWMC Multimodal plan, which is being funded through the CMAP Local Technical Assistance (LTA) program. The Request for Proposals (RFP) is currently being processed by CMAP and should be released soon. Once the RFP is released, staff will begin the consultant selection process and start the plan update.

NWMC staff also discussed the new STP Regional Shared Fund and Active Program Management policies. Staff reviewed the scoring methodology for projects applying to the Shared Fund and discussed correspondence between NWMC and CMAP throughout the process. The committee also discussed how the inclusion of bicycle and pedestrian elements could improve a project's score under the proposed methodology.

Finally, the committee discussed two recently announced grants. IDOT's Safe Routes to School Program will help fund select infrastructure projects within two miles of a middle or primary school, as well as non-infrastructure projects that focus on education, traffic enforcement and the encouragement of bicycling and walking.
