

Missed Recycling Pickup





Today's the Day to Submit 2019 Legislative Proposals

The annual call for legislative proposals was sent to the membership in August with a return date of September 14. Since the September NWMC Legislative Committee meeting was cancelled due to Yom Kippur, we extended the deadline to today, September 28 to forward initiatives for consideration in the 2019 NWMC Legislative Program.

The call for initiatives packet includes an interactive form that allows members to identify local issues, highlight those that require a legislative approach and describe any actions taken to address them to date. Federal issues should also be submitted at this time. The form also includes a sample response to assist in completing the request. Transportation Committee Discusses Freight, Metra and STAR Line

The NWMC Transportation Committee met Thursday and discussed the Cook County Freight Plan, Metra funding issues and disposition of remaining funds for the dormant STAR Line project. Cook County Department of Transportation Freight Manager Alex Beata reported that, after a two year planning process, the Cook County Board is expected to approve the plan this fall. He outlined issues relating to truck congestion, vertical clearance, pavement conditions, safety, at grade crossings and land use. He also highlighted the plan's recommendations for improvements to those problem areas.

Metra Community and Legislative Affairs Administrator Rick Mack told the committee that there will be no fare increase in 2019 but stated that the system would face continued deterioration and possible downsizing without a sustained capital program. He noted that the agency will need local elected leaders and riders to stress Metra's importance to the region with members of the General Assembly and to support increased, and reliable, transit funding. On a related note, the committee deferred discussion on specific provisions to be included in the next state infrastructure bill until the October meeting.

Finally, staff reported that the Northwest Municipal Conference's auditors highlighted a deferred revenue balance of \$25,212.99 in the long dormant STAR Line account during this year's audit. This funding is the remaining balance of what was contributed by communities along the proposed line to cover study and other project expenses. With this funding unlikely to be used for future project expenses, the committee voted to recommend returning the funds to the contributing municipalities on a pro rata basis. The recommendation will be considered by the NWMC Board at its October 10 meeting. *Staff contacts: Cole Jackson, Joshua Klingenstein*

Apply Now for Safe Routes to School Funding

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) has announced a new round of Safe Routes to School (SRTS) funding for Illinois. Between \$5 to \$6 million in funds is available statewide, with awards ranging from \$2,000 to \$200,000. For this year's round, there will be no local match required. Eligible infrastructure projects include: sidewalk improvements; traffic calming/speed reduction improvements; traffic control devices; pedestrian and bicycle crossing improvements; on-street and off-street bicycle facilities; and, secure bicycle parking facilities. Eligible non-infrastructure projects include: events; equipment; and, supplies that help to address areas of education, enforcement, encouragement, and evaluation.

Eligible sponsors include: schools or school district's political subdivisions (municipalities, cities, towns, etc.); metropolitan planning organizations/regional planning commissions; councils of government; local and regional agencies (law enforcement agencies, health departments, etc.); and, non-profit organizations. Every applicant must be registered through the Grant Accountability and Transparency Act (GATA) grantee portal, and all pre-award requirements must be fulfilled prior to submitting an SRTS application. The grantee portal link can be found by visiting https://grants.illinois.gov/portal/. While many municipalities have already registered through GATA, you may want to confirm with any school districts which are interested in applying that they are registered.

Applications will be accepted from September 24 to November 19.
