



#### Transportation Committee Talks State Capital Bill

The NWMC Transportation Committee met on October 25 and discussed the potential for a state capital bill and possible provisions that NWMC would like to see included. Regional Transportation Authority consultant Andy Plummer and Metra Community and Legislative Affairs Administrator Rick Mack both emphasized the urgent need for a capital bill and provided examples of projects that a capital bill could fund. Staff also discussed how the Transportation and Legislative committees could work together to prepare NWMC's advocacy effort in pursuit of a potential capital bill. The Committee directed staff to distribute a survey to get a better sense of the capital needs of NWMC members.

The Committee also discussed the status of the Surface Transportation Programs for the Northwest and North Shore Councils of Mayors, as well as future meeting discussion topics. The Illinois Housing Development Authority ("IHDA") is pleased to request the applications for Round 2 of the Home Accessibility Program (HAP). Under this program, IHDA will make grants to units of local government and nonprofit organizations to assist income-qualified households (elderly with a physical limitation or persons with disabilities) to facilitate necessary repairs to remain in their homes by improving accessibility and safety.

Maximum HAP grant funds of \$25,000 may be used to make necessary home repairs to tenant-occupied and owner-occupied properties to remove health and safety hazards in an effort to prevent premature or unnecessary institutionalization of elderly persons or persons with disabilities.
