

#### GREEN BAY RD AND CENTRAL ST

• Pedestrian safety should be a priority

 Bus stop location in the northwest corner is a concern. A bump-out should be provided.

• Relocate bus stop to Prairie Avenue

• UP railroad bridge pier on Central Street should be removed to provide left turn lane

• Provide east-west left turn signal on Central St


• Southbound right turn is a safety concern. Bollards should be considered in the northwest corner



**GREEN BAY ROAD** 


- Uncontrolled commuter crossings
