Robert Crown Community Center and Library Demolition of old Robert Crown Center

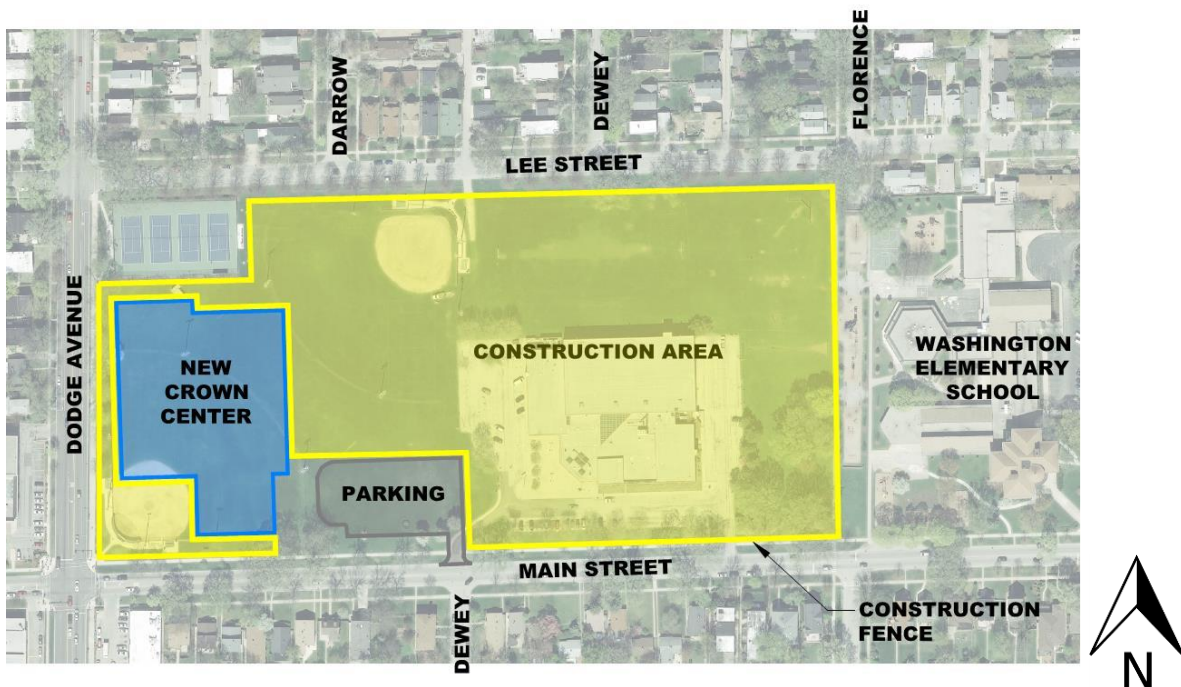
March 2, 2020

Beginning the week of March 9, 2020, the old Robert Crown Center is planned for demolition. The process is expected to require approximately seven weeks to complete as follows:

- Week 1: Mobilize equipment, and abate asbestos inside the building
- Weeks 2 to 4: Dismantle, separate and haul away above grade portions of the building
- Weeks 5 to 7: Excavate and remove building foundations

Demolition work will be conducted between 7:00 am and 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. Occasional work on Saturdays is possible depending on weather conditions and contractor progress.

A diagram highlighting the construction fence which is being erected around the old Crown Center and its parking lot for this work is below.





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During asbestos abatement work, the contractor will follow all OSHA, IEPA, Cook County, and IDPH regulations to ensure the safety of abatement workers, and the general public as well as for proper handling and disposal of asbestos containing materials. Additionally, an independent environmental engineering firm will perform ambient air monitoring to ensure air quality requirements are met.

During demolition work, the contractor will follow all OSHA requirements and the Cook County Environmental Control Ordinance to ensure the safety of both demolition workers and the general public. Water will be used extensively to control dust and dirt from becoming airborne. Ambient air monitoring will be performed by an independent environmental engineering firm to ensure air quality requirements are met. Vibration monitoring equipment will also be installed to alert the contractor in the event construction related vibrations approach levels which could potentially damage adjacent structures.
