General Fund Balance

- In 2021 Proposed Budget \$1 million contribution; \$500,000 from property taxes
- Fund balance policy 16.6% of expenses
- General Fund balance is an important indicator to reflect the financial health of the city
- Rating agencies review fund balance history as one of the main indicators to get a true sense of the financial picture of the community




General Fund Balance

- Scenario 1: Annual contribution of \$1,000,000
 - Reach policy goal by 2025
- Scenario 2: Annual contribution of \$500,000
 - Still short of policy goal by \$2.5 million in 2025
- Scenario 3: Contribution of \$500,000, increasing by \$500,000 each year
 - Reach policy goal by 2024
