**AN ORDINANCE**  
**Amending Title 10, Chapter 11, Section 18, Schedule XVIII (P)**  
**Residents Only Parking Districts**

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
 EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** City Code Section 10-11-18 Schedule XVIII (P) “Residents Only Parking Districts”, of the Evanston City Code of 2012, as amended, is hereby further amended to add a portion of Sheridan Square, and read as follows:

(P) District R: 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., every day:

SCHEDULE XVIII (P): RESIDENTS PARKING ONLY DISTRICTS		
Sheridan Square	Both sides	Entire length
<p>The following residents are eligible to apply for and purchase permits for district R: Those residents having a legal address on Sheridan Square, Sheridan Road between South Boulevard and Kedzie Avenue, Sheridan Road between South Boulevard and Sheridan Square (south intersection), and South Boulevard and Keeney Avenue between Sheridan Road and Michigan Avenue.</p> <p>Parking is permitted without a R District Permit between the hours of 6:00 am and 9:00 pm with a three (3) hour maximum on the east side of Sheridan Square from Garden Park to Sheridan Road. <u>Parking on the west side of Sheridan Square from Garden Park to Sheridan Road allows for R District Permit holders only.</u></p>		

**SECTION 2:** The findings and recitals contained herein are declared to be prima facie evidence of the law of the City and shall be received in evidence as provided by the Illinois Compiled Statutes and the courts of the State of Illinois.

**SECTION 3:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.


