This addendum forms a part of the RFP Documents for RFP # 22-04 and modifies these documents. This addendum consists of the following:

Clarifications to Questions Received:

- 1. Question: Does participation in this project as a sub consultant (or prime) preclude a consultant from working on future phases of this project?
 - Response: Participation on the selected team for this project will not preclude working on future phases of this project.
- Question: The RFP mentions that the floor plans are sketch quality and need to be field verified. Is the expectation that the full building be measured and plans updated, or is a general verification that the room layouts are correct, sufficient to meet the goals of this study? Response: General verification that the room layouts on the architectural drawings are correct will be sufficient for this study.
- 3. Question: Is the M/W/EBE requirement met by either an MBE, WBE, or EBE? Response: Yes, that is correct.
- 4. Question: Is there a particular software requirement for the energy model? Response: No, there is not a specific software required.
- 5. Question: Is there a particular certification requirement for the Historical Preservation Specialist?
 - Response: A licensed architect with experience in the field of historic preservation will be necessary. Please be aware that although there are no specific tasks indicated that require an historic preservationist, all of the tasks must take into account the historic nature of the building. Demonstrating an understanding of how to provide this sensitivity will be among the key evaluation criteria.
