






What is your age?






How do you plan to get to the skate park (in good weather)?






What are your wheels of choice?






What is your preferred ratio of STREET to TRANSITION terrain?







What is your vision for the Evanston Skate Park?

- **1. All ages, all skills, all wheels,** including skateboarders, longboarders, rollerskaters, in-line skaters, BMX bikers, bikers + scooters.
- 2. Safe and accessible, including good access and mellow transitions.
- 3. Well lit and accommodating of nighttime uses with no dark spots.
- 4. Well-placed obstacles that support good flow.
- 5. A bowl plus a combination of street plaza style features.
- 6. Places for activity and places to watch + rest.
- **7. Attractive, unique + vibrant.** State of the art park for Evanston, unlike other nearby parks.
- 8. Inclusive of amenities such as shade, water fountain, bathrooms and landscaping.
- 9. Durable + Maintainable.
- 10.Bring Evanston's skating community together.

What else should we focus on?

- **1. Quality construction,** including smooth transitions and surfacing.
- **2. Good drainage** so that the park can be used after it rains.
- **3. Incorporate art** and consider working with local artists.
- 4. Provide (tethered) repair tools.
- 5. Provide first aid kits.
- 6. Consider an emergency notification station.
- 7. Add more trees and landscaping to offset the loss of grass.
- 8. Consider programming, such as classes, competitions + outdoor concerts.
- 9. Provide food and drink options, such as food truck events.
- 10. Continue to involve the skating community in the development of the skate park.
