Traffic Control & Logistics:

This portion of the project will require 2 right of way closures.

Phase 2 will be a closure of the sidewalk on the South side of Church St. Access to the existing pay box will be maintained at all times. – See exhibit "A"

Phase 3 will require closure of the alley to the West of the property. - - See exhibit "A"

Construction:

The construction for this portion of the project is largely limited to demolition of lot lite buildings. The project will 4 intermediate phases – see exhibit "A"

Phase 1 - Mobilize and erect inward swinging gate in alley.

Phase 2 – Sidewalk closure along Church St to allow for removal of wall and canopies.

Phase 3 – Alley closure to all for removal of lot line walls

Phase 4 – Final clean up and etc.

Project Schedule:

The overall schedule is contingent upon receipt of permits and weather.

Contractor Parking:

We anticipate a majority of the contractor parking to be on site. Any overflow parking would be directed to the surface lots indicated in Exhibit "C" 1614 Maple Ave & 621 Oak Ave.

Delivery Routes & Logistics:

The project site will have a small area at the South East corner of the property. See attached Exhibit "A" showing the area for contractor parking, equipment storage, and dumpster/toilet area. All equipment and material deliveries to and from the site will follow all appropriate rules and regulations. Trucks will approach the site by heading East on Church St, turn South on Oak Ave, and then turn East in to the alley. This is shown on Exhibit B with the green arrow indicating the proposed truck route.

Verification of Existing Conditions:

This project has been broken up into two primary phases: Phase 1 Demolition & Phase 2 New Construction. The final design and construction schedule are pending but are anticipated to take place in 2023-2024.


The current demolition phase is limited to removal of all above ground building structures and elements. The existing foundations are being left in place for the duration of this phase. We will hand dig to verify dimensions and depths. Final scope of work will be executed during the new construction of Phase 2.


"The Barn" is a tenant of the property owner and the project team has been in regular contact with their staff.


Work Site Communications:


The project team will update the property owners or management companies of buildings as required by the permitting process. The notifications will be in writing delivered by U.S. mail, email, and/or other means supported by the property owners or management companies. The initial notification will be made at least one week prior to mobilization for the project. Updates will be delivered. All public right of way closures will have posted notifications 48 hours prior to their start. A sign with emergency contact information for the general contractor's key employees will be posted on, or on the fence panel next to, the primary access gate. A development sign with the project name, rendering and project description will be provided on the gate or the fence panel adjacent thereto and a board at this location will provide project updates.













City of Evanston Truck Routes
