3. PUBLIC COMMENT

4. COMMUNICATION

A. Community Equity Survey Report

City of Evanston Fellow Matt Ouren presented some findings from the community equity survey. The Commission discussed creating a formal report to share with the community.

5. DISCUSSION

A. Anti-Gentrification Ordinances

Chair Thomas gave a presentation giving context for the anti-gentrification ordinances and outlining the proposed path for the changes. The language for the first ordinance is about preventing predatory purchasing. A second recommendation is to maintain the unit count of any building under four units. The third recommendation is for a low-interest loan for creating Accessory Dwelling Unit homes. The fourth recommendation was to raise the fine for demolishing homes. The final recommendation was to make affordable housing units affordable in perpetuity. The Commission intends to make formal recommendations in upcoming meetings.
