

- Account for new spaces, like the plazas and parks, created by the project



Commencement, convocation and graduations	No change
University-sponsored lectures, speakers, musical performances and other cultural events held within an enclosed building (max 10,000 capacity)	Amend to include other community events that may not be solely sponsored by the University Indoor and outdoor
Luncheons, dinners, and dining room facilities in a stadium (max seating capacity of facility)	Amend to include other private events (such as non-profit fundraisers)
Community and cultural events of a nonprofit nature intended primarily for residents of the City and amateur athletic events; Max 10,000 capacity No more than 7 events in any calendar year in any one facility and each event shall not exceed 5 consecutive days in duration	Increase to stadium capacity (35,000) Clarify includes concerts Maximum 12 events total
