AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 7-11-4(D) of the Evanston City Code Regulating Beach Hours

WHEREAS, for reasons of public safety, the City Council provides a life-saving service for each of the City's lakefront swimming areas; and

WHEREAS, during certain times of the beach season weather may negatively affect patron safety; and

WHEREAS, seasonal lakefront staff is often unavailable after July because of higher education commitments,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Evanston, Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That section 7-11-4(D) of the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended as follows:

7-11-4(D):

The City Manager or his designee may, based upon existing weather, attendance-conditions-and/or-staffing capabilities,-extend-the-aforementioned-schedule,-Section (A)-above conditions and/or beach attendance, extend the aforementioned schedule, Section (A) above. Conversely, when weather and/or staffing capabilities negatively affect public safety, the City Manager or his designee may decrease the scheduled hours, reduce the swimming area, or close beaches for swimming.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and

effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
