AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 3-5-1 of the Evanston City Code Relating to Definition of "Applicant" for a Liquor License

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-5-1 of Title 3, Chapter 5 of the Evanston City Code of 1979, as amended, be and it hereby is further amended by adding to the definition of "applicant" and by defining "combination store", as follows:

Section 3-5-1: Applicant:

An individual, copartnership or corporation which seeks to be licensed under the provisions of this Chapter. In the case of a club, "applicant" shall mean the officers, directors, and person operating as manager, and in the case of a corporation, it shall mean the officers, directors, all persons owning directly or beneficially more than five percent (5%) of the stock of such corporation and the person operating as manager of the premises. In the case of a combination grocery/drug store, "applicant" shall mean the officers, directors, all persons owning directly or beneficially more than five percent (5%) of the stock of the entity having charge of the licensed premises and the person(s) operating as manager(s) of the premises.

Combination Drug/Grocery Store:

A store with affiliated drug and grocery companies managing a combination drug and grocery store as a single store under one roof.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
