

AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 3-5-6 of the City Code of the City of Evanston, Relating to Liquor Licenses

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-5-6 of the Code of the City of Evanston, 1979, as amended, be and hereby it is further amended to read as follows:

(L) CLASS L licenses, which shall authorize the sale of beer and wine for consumption on the premises where served, limited to patrons of a theater presenting live stage performances during a period limited to one hour prior to the start of the performance and during intermission(s); provided, that sales and consumption are restricted to lobby areas.

The annual single payment fee for initial issuance or renewal of such license shall be.....\$1,000.00

The total fee required hereunder for renewal applicants electing to make semi-annual payments, payable pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-5-7 hereof, shall be.....\$1,050.00

No more than zero such licenses shall be in force at any one time.

The sale of beer and wine is prohibited in theaters located in public buildings. (Ord. 27-0-91)

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
