AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 10-1-6-2(B) of the Evanston City Code, 1979

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 10-1-6-2, REGULATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, Paragraph (B), Regulation of Signs on Public Right of Way, be amended to read as follows:

Regulation of Signs on Public Right of Way: No permanent signs other than those necessary for the regulation, warning, or guidance of traffic shall be placed in the public right of way. Specifications for these signs are found in the sources listed in subsection (A) above. Regulatory signs include, but are not limited to, all signs necessary for the enforcement of parking and traffic regulations. Guide signs include all directional signs containing necessary public information. Nonregulatory signs in place prior to August 1, 1989, and all Neighborhood Watch signs are exempted from this regulation. Exceptions to this regulation may only be granted by the Sign Review and Appeals Board.

SECTION 2: That ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
