An Ordinance

Amending Section 9-2-3 of the City Code, Relating to Fees for
Transportation to a Hospital

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON,
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 9-2-3 of the Code of the City of
Evanston, 1979, as amended, be and it is hereby
amended to read as follows:

9-2-3: FEES CHARGED: USE OF EQUIPMENT

- (A) The Fire Chief may charge a reasonable fee for all salvage and
overhaul work performed; and for use of fire equipment and
personnel. Such fees shall not exceed actual costs plus ten
percent (10%) and all fees collected shall be remitted to the
City Collector.
- (B) The Fire Chief shall charge a fee, in the amount of one
hundred dollars (\$100.00), to all residents of the City of
Evanston when transported by the Fire Department to a
hospital. In addition, the Fire Chief shall charge a fee, in
the amount of two hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$225.00) to
all Non-Evanston residents when transported to a hospital.
All fees shall be remitted to the City Collector.
- (C) Non-emergency use of Fire Department personnel, vehicles,
equipment or buildings shall not be permitted without the
written approval by the Fire Chief or his duly authorized
representative.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage, approval,
and publication in the manner provided by law.
