AN ORDINANCE

Repealing Title 26, Chapter 3
(Farmer's Market Commission)

WHEREAS, on April 2, 1991, citizens of Evanston passed a referendum to reduce the size of the City Council from eighteen to nine members; and

WHEREAS, the reduction in the size of the City Council will occur effective upon the election of April, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the reduction in the size of the City Council is a fundamental change in the manner in which the City will conduct its business and affairs; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the reduction, it is necessary that the functions and purposes of certain City boards and commissions be consolidated; and

WHEREAS, the duties and functions of the Farmers Market Commission can be more appropriately and efficiently accomplished by the Human Services Committee of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 29-R-93 provides that the Human Services Committee shall have oversight of the Farmer's Market.

WHEREAS, the Human Services Committee is a standing Committee of the City Council with specific duties as set forth in rule 9.5 of the Rules of Organization of the City Council of the City of Evanston;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF EVANSTON:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 26 of Title 3 of the City Code
of Evanston is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force
and effect from and after May 11, 1993.
