AN ORDINANCE

Amending Sections 10-11-7, 10-11-8, 10-11-12, and 10-11-22 of the Evanston City Code, 1979

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding to Section 10-11-7, Schedule VII(A), PASSENGER LOADING ZONES, the following:

Greenleaf Street South side, Elmwood Avenue to Sherman Avenue

SECTION 2: That the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding to Section 10-11-7, Schedule VII(B), LOADING ZONES, the following:

Sherman Avenue West side, Main Street to a point 40 feet north thereof

SECTION 3: That the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding to Section 10-11-8, Schedule VIII(A), PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES, the following:

Sherman Avenue Within 20 feet of entrances to City Parking Lots 8 and 31

Greenleaf Street South side, Asbury Avenue to Chicago Avenue

SECTION 4: That the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding to Section 10-11-10, Schedule X(C), TWO-HOUR PARKING, the following:

Main Street

Both sides, Hinman Avenue to Judson Avenue

Sherman Avenue

Both sides, Main Street to Washington

Street

SECTION 5: That the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding to Section 10-11-10, Schedule X(F), LIMITED PARKING, EXCEPTIONS, the following:

Sherman Avenue Both sides, Main Street to Washington Street

SECTION 6: That the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding to Section 10-11-12, Schedule XII(E), PARKING METER ZONES, the following:

Parking Lot #31, 925 Sherman Avenue \$0.25 per hour Maximum limit, two hours

SECTION 7: That the Evanston City Code, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding to Section 10-11-22, Schedule XXII(A), EVANSTON RESIDENT ONLY PARKING DISTRICTS, the following:

Sherman Avenue Both Sides, Main Street to Lee Street

Elmwood Avenue Both Sides, Main Street to Lee Street

Maple Avenue Both Sides, Main Street to Lee Street

SECTION 8: That ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 10: That this ordinance shall be repealed when the Main Street Combined Sewer Rehabilitation Project is completed, expected to be no later than September 10, 1993.
