AN ORDINANCE

Levying Taxes for the Special Service Area No. 4
of the City of Evanston, County of Cook
and State of Illinois for the Fiscal Year

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston, Illinois is a Home Rule unit of local government pursuant to the terms and provisions of Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois which said Constitution in Section 6 (A) thereof grants unto the City of Evanston as Home Rule unit of local government the power to tax;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That in order to meet expenses and liabilities of the Special Service Area #4 of the City of Evanston, Illinois, for the current fiscal year beginning March 1, 1995, there is hereby levied on all real property subject to taxation within the limits of said Special Service Area #4 of the City of Evanston as assessed and equalized for the year 1995, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) being the total of the appropriation heretofore legally made plus allowances for collection losses, which are to be collected from the tax levy of Special Service Area #4 of the City of Evanston for the year 1995.

The specific amounts levied for the various purposes and funds are designated by being placed in separate columns under headings "TO BE RAISED BY TAXATION" and are identified in that manner on the following page of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: That there be appropriated for the City of Evanston
