AN ORDINANCE

Amending Chapter 18 of Title 8 of the
Evanston City Code Pertaining to Child Day Care Homes

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the definition of "Child Day Care Home" in Section 8-18-1
of the City Code of the City of Evanston, 1979, as amended, be and hereby is further
amended to read as follows:

8-18-1: DEFINITIONS:

CHILD DAY CARE HOME: A family home which regularly provides day care for less than twenty-four (24) hours per day for not more than eight (8) children, under twelve years of age, except that up to 10 children may be served if: 1) at least two of the children are school-age (age 6-11 and 5-years-old in full day kindergarten) who may be cared for only before and/or after school, on school holidays, during unforeseen school closings, and during the summer; 2) the home is licensed by the State for the intended number of children; and 3) the home employs an assistant caregiver who meets State qualifications, is at least 18 years of age, and who shall be present at all times when school children are present. The maximum of eight (8) or ten (10) children includes the family's natural foster or adopted children and all other persons under age twelve (12).

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and

after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
