## AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 3-5-6 of the Code of the City of Evanston, 1979, as Amended, Increasing the Number of Class D Alcoholic Liquor Licenses

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-5-6(D) of the City Code of the City of Evanston, 1979, as amended, be further amended to read as follows:

(D) CLASS D licenses, which shall duplicate Class C licenses in all regards except that beer and/or wine only shall be served. It shall be unlawful for any person licensed hereunder to sell alcoholic liquor at a bar as defined in Section 3-5-1 hereof, except to persons attending a reception or party not open to the public. The applicants for the renewal only of such licenses may elect to pay the amount required herein semi-annually or annually. Such election shall be made at the time of application.

No more than twenty one (21) such licenses shall be in force at any one time.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
