AN ORDINANCE

Amending Ordinance 110-0-99 Pertaining to the Sale of Surplus Property

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance 110-0-99 on September 13, 1999; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 110-0-99 provided for the sale of a Conveyer Sorting System to Peak Equipment for \$20,500; and

WHEREAS, Peak Equipment has now determined that it is not economically feasible to purchase the Conveyor Sorting System; and

WHEREAS, Ely Enterprises offered the second bid of \$10,000 in response to the City's bid package and now wishes to purchase said equipment,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 2 of Ordinance 110-0-99 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2: That pursuant to said Section 1-17-3(B), the City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to sell upon terms and conditions he deems reasonable, necessary, and in the best interest of the City, the aforescribed surplus property now owned by the City of Evanston as follows: Baler to Ely Enterprises for \$45,000, Conveyor Sorting System to Ely Enterprises for \$10,000 and Various Storage Containers to Firstar Fiber, Inc. for \$5,701.00.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
