AN ORDINANCE

**Amending Section 3-5-1 of the
Liquor Control Regulations
To Add the Definition of "Brew Pub"**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That section 3-5-1, "Definitions", of the Liquor Control Regulations Ordinance of the Evanston City Code of 1979, as amended, be and it hereby is, further amended, by adding the following definition of "Brew Pub" in appropriate alphabetical order:

Brew Pub

"Brew Pub" means a manufacturer of beer only at a designated premises to make sales to importing distributors, distributors, and to non-licensees for use and consumption only, who stores beer at the designated premises, and who is allowed to sell at retail from the licensed premises, provided that a brew pub licensee shall not sell for off-premises consumption more than 50,000 gallons per year.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
