AN ORDINANCE

Adding a New Section 3-5-6(AC) to the Alcoholic
Liquor Regulations to Create the Arts Cinema
Class AC Liquor License

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the Alcoholic Liquor Regulations Ordinance of the Evanston City
Code of 1979, as amended, be and it hereby is, further amended, by adding a new section 3-5-6(AC)
to read as follows:

3-5-6(A) CLASS AC licenses, which shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption
on the premises while food service is available and served only by waitstaff at a table at
an Arts Cinema having a minimum seating capacity of eight hundred (800), in the Core
District. Establishments holding Class AC licenses must have some food service
available when alcoholic liquor is being sold. Each Class AC License shall be subject to
the following conditions:

1. Sale, possession, and consumption of alcoholic liquor shall be restricted to the café
area. Sale, possession, and consumption of alcoholic liquor in the viewing auditorium
is prohibited.
2. The sale of alcoholic liquor shall only take place from eleven o' clock (11:00) A.M.
to one o'clock (1:00) A.M. Sunday through Saturday.
3. No licensee shall employ on its premises any person under the age of twenty-one (21)
years to attend bar, or to pour, draw, or mix alcoholic liquor on said premises.

The annual single-payment fee for initial
issuance or renewal of such license shall be \$5,000.00

The total fee required hereunder for renewal
applicants electing to make semiannual payments,
payable pursuant to the provisions of Section
3-5-7 of this Chapter, shall be\$5,250.00

No more than zero (0) such licenses shall be in force at any one time.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
