**AN ORDINANCE**

**Amending Ordinance 38-O-00  
To Extend The Sunset Provision**

WHEREAS, the City Council did pass, on June 12, 2000, Ordinance 38-O-00 which prohibits the booting of motor vehicles by private parties; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 38-O-00 included a sunset provision providing that the Ordinance would terminate and be of no effect ninety (90) days from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law unless affirmatively adopted by City Council action; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** That Section 3 of Ordinance 38-O-00 is hereby amended by deleting the phrase "ninety (90) days" and substituting in lieu thereof the phrase, "one hundred thirty-five (135) days."

**SECTION 2:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:** That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
