AN ORDINANCE

**Amending Section 3-5-6(G) of the City Code of the
City of Evanston, Regarding an Increase in the Number of
Class G Liquor Licenses from Zero to One,
Increase the License Fee and Revise the
Hours of Permitted Sales of Beer and Wine**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-5-6(G) of the City Code of the City of Evanston of 1979,
as amended, is hereby further amended by increasing the number of Class G licenses from zero to
one to read as follows:

3-5-6 (G)Class G licenses, which shall authorize in the "Retail Package Store Area", as
defined in Section 3-5-1 of this Chapter, the retail sale in package stores of beer and
wine in original packages to persons of at least twenty one (21) years of age for
consumption off the premises. The applicant for a Class G license shall pay a first
year license fee of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00). Thereafter, the annual fee
for a Class G license shall be three thousand three hundred dollars (\$3,300.00).
Each Class G license shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. It shall be unlawful for a Class G licensee to sell a single container of beer unless
the volume of the container is equal to or greater than forty (40) fluid ounces or 1.18
liters.
2. It shall be unlawful for a Class G licensee to sell a single container of wine unless
the container is greater than sixteen (16) fluid ounces or 0.473 liters.
3. The sale of beer and wine at retail pursuant to the Class G license may begin
after eight o'clock (8:00) A.M., Monday through Sunday. Beer and wine shall not be
sold after the hour of ten o'clock (10:00) P.M. on any day.

No more than (1) such licenses shall be in force at any one time.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby
repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
