AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 3-5-6 (O) of the City Code of the City of Evanston, to Decrease the Number of Class O Liquor Licenses from Six to Five

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-5-6(O) of the City Code of the City of Evanston of 1979, as amended, is hereby further amended by decreasing the number of Class O licenses from 6 to 5 to read as follows:

- 3-5-6 (O) Class O licenses, which shall authorize the retail sale of beer and wine in grocery stores and combination stores, as defined in section 3-5-1 of this chapter, in original packages to persons of at least twenty-one (21) years of age for consumption off the premises. The applicant for such license shall pay an initial fee of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000). The annual renewal fee for the renewal of a class O license is four thousand one hundred dollars (\$4,100.00).
 - 1. It shall be unlawful for a class O licensee to sell a single container of beer unless the volume of the container is equal to or greater than forty (40) fluid ounces or 1.18 liters.
 - 2. It shall be unlawful for a class O licensee to sell a single container of wine unless the container is greater than or equal to sixteen (16) fluid ounces or 0.473 liters.
 - 3. The sale of alcoholic liquor at retail pursuant to the class O license may begin after eight o'clock (8:00 A.M.) Monday through Sunday. Alcoholic liquor shall not be sold after the hour of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight on any day.
 - 4. A class O licensee shall provide a minimum of twelve thousand (12,000) square feet of production, preparation,

and display area in which products are prepared and are for sale.

The total number of class O licenses in force at any one time shall not exceed five (5).

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
