**AN ORDINANCE**

**Amending Ordinance 38-O-00  
To Extend the Sunset Provision an  
Additional 90 Days on the Immobilization of  
Vehicles on Private Property by Private Entities**

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable for all areas of the City of Evanston to have legal and convenient access to vehicle parking; and

**WHEREAS**, the illegal parking of vehicles on private property in all areas of the City of Evanston has resulted in economic hardship for property owners, which in turn, negatively impacts the surrounding community; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Evanston to protect the property rights of its residents and business owners;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Evanston has determined that the services provided by the vehicle immobilization or "booting" industry deters illegal parking and may in some cases be a more efficient means of protecting these property rights;

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle immobilization or "booting" industry is not currently regulated in the State of Illinois or the City of Evanston;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** That Section 3 of Ordinance 38-O-00 is hereby amended by deleting the phrase "three hundred fifty (350) days" and substituting in lieu thereof the

phrase four hundred and forty (440) days," thereby extending the sunset provision to October 9, 2001.

**SECTION 2:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:** That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
