AN ORDINANCE

**Amending Ordinance 102-O-01 to
Extend the Trial Period Regulating
Private Vehicle Immobilization
Within the Central Business District**

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2001, the Evanston city council passed Ordinance 102-O-01 which established a six-month trial period regulating private vehicle immobilization within the Central Business District; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of Evanston to extend said trail period for one year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3 of Ordinance 102-O-01 is hereby amended by deleting that section in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following new Section 3:

"SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law, provided that this ordinance shall terminate on April 1, 2003, unless affirmatively adopted by City Council action."

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
