AN ORDINANCE

**Amending Section 3-5-6 (D) of the
City Code to Increase the Number of
Class D Liquor Licenses From 20 to 21**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK
COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-5-6 (D) of the Evanston City Code of the City of
Evanston, 1979, as amended, be and it hereby is further amended, to read as follows:

SECTION 3-5-6 (D): CLASS D licenses, which shall duplicate class C
licenses in all regards except that beer and/or wine only shall be served. It
shall be unlawful for any person licensed hereunder to sell "alcoholic liquor"
at a "bar", as defined in section 3-5-1 of this chapter, except to persons
attending a reception or party not open to the public. The applicants for the
renewal only of such licenses may elect to pay the amount required herein
semiannually or annually. Such election shall be made at the time of
application.

The annual single-payment fee for initial
issuance or renewal of such licenses shall be\$1,800.00

The total fee required hereunder for renewal
applicants electing to make seminannual payments,
payable pursuant to the provisions of section
3-5-7 of this chapter, shall be\$1,890.00

No more than twenty-one (21) such licenses shall be in force at any one
time.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are
hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
