AN ORDINANCE

Amending Title 3, Chapter 5 of the City Code of the City of Evanston, to Create a New Class W Liquor License

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1 That Title 3, Chapter 5 of the City Code of 1979 be, and it hereby is further amended, by adding a new Section 3-5-6 (W) to read as follows:

3-5-6 (W) CLASS W licenses, which shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises where sold, when such premises is operated for the primary purpose of presenting live musical performances, for compensation. Patrons may be served at table or at a bar installed to accommodate such service. Such licenses may be issued only to establishments located on the core area. The meaning of "core area" and, live musical shall be as defined in section 3-5-1 of this chapter.

The applicant for the renewal only of such licenses may elect to pay the amount herein semiannually. Such election shall be made at the time of application.

The annual single payment fee for initial issuance or renewal of such licenses shall be \$8,000.00
The total fee required hereunder for renewal applicants electing to make semi-annual payments, payable pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-5-1 of this chapter \$8,400.00

The sale of alcoholic liquor shall not take place between the hours of two-o'clock (2:00) A.M. and four o'clock (4:00) P.M., except that sales may be made up to three o'clock (3:00) A.M. on Friday, Saturday, Sunday mornings and up to three o'clock (3:00) A.M. on the mornings of January 1, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, and Thanksgiving. The sale of alcoholic liquor shall not take place more than two hours before a live performance begins nor more than two hours after the end of a live performance.

No more than zero such licenses shall be in force at any one time.

SECTION 2 That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3 That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
